We offer single day instruction for \$250.00, p.p. The client will be familiarized with all aspects of basic sled dog care from morning feeding through hook-up. Your initial driving instruction will come on a double sled with an instructor at your side. This is an excellent hands-on opportunity to learn when and how to use proper commands, equipment and control of a sled. You will also have the opportunity to drive your own team and sled on a 10-12 mile run. The time requirement for this is approximately 8 hours. Lunch provided. No housing provided.

2- day trips; The first day will be spent familiarizing the client with basic dog care and sled handling techniques on the double sled. There will also be the opportunity for you to run your own team on a short run, the difficulty depending on your ability and comfort level. Day 2 will consist of a longer sled run from the Kennel headquarters, again, the distance and difficulty will depend on the client's comfort level and skill. \$225.00 per day, p.p. lodging and food provided

3-5 day trips; Day one will again be the orientation day. Day 2 will be a one-way trip to a remote camp for an overnight on the trail. 3-day trips will be to a comfortable tent camp, while longer trips may incorporate a stay at a remote cabin or Lodge. \$225.00 per day, p.p. lodging and food provided.

We also offer a 3-day course geared toward the serious musher. Bring your own 6-dog team and learn advanced dog care, winter survival and dog training techniques from two-time Yukon Quest winner, John Schandelmeier. This is an intensive training course and we put as much as possible into the short 3-day period. There will be a camp-out and dogs need to come prepared to do a minimum of 30-mile runs. Dog care will include foot care, basic veterinary and advanced feeding options. Training will include no-discipline techniques that work and various types of running schedules that are presently being used for both racing and long-distance travel. Survival training will cover good basic cold-weather gear and how to camp outside comfortably with minimal equipment.
